

## CECA 2024 Traffic Survey Results Summary- July 6, 2024

A summary of the survey results from the 2024 Traffic Survey conducted in May to June of 2024. There were 18 questions asked with 84 responses. I will summarize each questions results, with the full summary will be saved on the shared drive and will eventually be made available to the community by posting on the CECA website and a link to the website on social media. The survey results will also be sent the CRO, city councillor, CBE/CCSD transportation, Evergreen schools, and city transportation. 1. Modes of transportation around Evergreen were ranked. They were:
  - a. Motorized vehicles
  - b. Walk
  - c. Transit
  - d. Bicycle
2. Next it was asked the top 3 traffic concerns that people have with in Evergreen. They were:
  - a. Excessive vehicle speed
  - b. Congested traffic around schools
  - c. Car parked in bad locations
3. Do you think Evergreen has enough marked crosswalks.
  - a. 58.3% of people responded yes.
4. People were asked to list the top three intersections that need more attention. The top 3 were:
  - a. Fish Creek Blvd @ Everbrook Dr (W)- 17
  - b. Everstone Dr @ Everridge Dr- 10
  - c. Fish Creek Blvd @ Everstone Dr- 8
5. What measure should be taken to increase pedestrian safety? The most requested item was 'More pedestrian crossing lights. We will have to determine where this makes sense.
6. Do you use the pathways in Evergreen? 94% responded yes.
7. Those that responded yes in question 6, the reason was for exercise, leisurely stroll, and accessing playgrounds.
8. What measures would you be comfortable with being implemented to slow traffic at playground zones? 63% responded to speed humps/ cushions. This will depend on an application to the city and available city budget.
9. What would people like to see on Fish Creek Blvd, Everstone Dr, and Everridge Dr, to slow traffic? 60% responded yes to speed humps/cushions. Once again this will depend on city budget.
10. Have you had issues with snow removal or street cleaning? 63% responded No.
11. If there was a community meeting to discuss traffic issues, would you attend? 54% responded Maybe, and 27% responded Yes. So, it make be advantageous for CECA to hold a traffic and safety forum.
12. Has the resident or family member been involved in roadway or pathway incident? Fortunately, 77% responded No.
13. Has the resident contacted anyone regarding traffic concerns? 48% responded with 311, but 44% said No One.
14. Was an open-ended question where people could list traffic issues not covered in the survey. Most respondents reiterated speeding in playground zones which had been listed.
15. Another open-ended question where people could list anything they would like CECA to know. Some comments were:
  - a. Better traffic in Evergreen than other communities
  - b. Condition of the fencing surrounding Evergreen
  - c. A request for more policing
  - d. A request for a traffic and safety forum for Evergreen
16. Are you a resident of Evergreen? This question was optional. 95% of respondents were.
17. Asked for what area of Evergreen respondents were from. This question was optional. The top 4 areas responding were. Eversyde, Everbrook, Everridge, and Everhollow. 3 of those areas have a school.
