all organics; non-recyclable and non-hazardous items for landfill – users also reminded to use the City blue bin program for recycling	
organics: must be in paper bags or loose	broken/damaged furniture, mattresses, misc. glass and plastic
yard waste, trees, garbage, wood, planter boxes, flower pots, bird baths, misc. rock, concrete, non-metal patio furniture	renovation junk: doors, tile, rugs, sinks, toilets, shower enclosures

NOTE: We CAN NOT accept the following items at this time (see also Household Hazardous Waste FAQ)

NO large furniture for donation	NO appliances containing freon/coolant: refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners
NO objects containing mercury: wall thermostats, fluorescent bulbs	NO objects containing radioisotopes: smoke detectors
NO alkaline or rechargeable batteries	NO household chemicals
NO paints, solvents, fuel, oil, brake and transmission fluid, antifreeze	NO hazardous, flammable, or pressurized goods or their containers: gasoline or propane tanks, fire extinguishers, spray paint

NO BBQs, garden tools, lawn mowers, auto parts, scrap metal, etc.
